

# VES/VPS DRESS CODE 2017~2018



The dress code is established to teach grooming and hygiene, to prevent disruption, and minimize safety hazards. Students and parents may determine a student's personal dress and grooming standards, provided that they comply with the following:

- All clothing must be properly hemmed/cuffed. **No holes or rips in jeans.**
- **Boys are not allowed to wear earrings**
- Hair must be neatly groomed and out of eyes, of a natural color, and no extreme or fad hair-dos, such as: mohawks or designs cut into the hair.

Campus administration will have complete and final judgment on all matters concerning interpretation of the student dress code.

## SHIRTS, BLOUSES, TURTLENECKS, SWEATERS, SWEATSHIRTS:

- All shirts must be appropriately sized in the shoulders and length (No bare shoulders)
- **Only school appropriate words and pictures will be allowed**
- No sheer or see-through tops
- No bare midriffs
- No tank tops or "spaghetti strap" shirts
- Appropriate dress must be worn under sweaters/sweatshirts and jackets

## JEANS, PANTS, SHORTS, SKORTS, SKIRTS, DRESSES:

- Jeans, pants or slacks of any color
- No low-rise or oversized styles
- Shorts, skirts, skorts, and dresses should be a minimum of one inch past fingertips when the student's hand is fully extended down the side of the leg **even when worn with tights or leggings**

## FOOTWEAR:

- Athletic shoes or other shoes that are appropriate for P.E./recess with both closed toe and heel  
**\*\*as students have P.E. everyday**
- No flip-flops, sandals or house shoes
- No Heely's, skate shoes, or cleats

## OUTERWEAR:

- Hats, caps, and sunglasses are not to be worn in the building, except on school approved dress up days
